Activity Summary

Performance Improvement Assessment (PIA) is one of the key activities that mark the beginning of TCI work-plan implementation across supported high volume sites (HVS) in the state. The PIA helps the state to document the situation of HR capacity, FP methods availability, equipment and infrastructural status of the facilities.

Following the selection of 25 HVS in Bauchi State for implementation in year 1 under the Challenge Initiative, it became imperative to conduct PIA for these sites for the above-mentioned reasons.

The PIA activity which held from February 19 to 23, 2018 consists of a training on the PIA tool, facility visits for assessment, data synthesis and development of the Performance Improvement Plan (PIP).

The training held at Chartwell Hotel in Bauchi State on the 19th February 2018 with 17 participants (M8 F9) in attendance. The participants included the LGA RH and M&E coordinators across the 5 selected LGAs for implementation and the State FP team at State Ministry of Health and Primary Health Development Agency. The training was facilitated by the State FP Coordinator, with support from the TCI team. The training covered overview of FP and review of the PIA tool.

	<p>Days 2 and 3 (Feb 20 – 21, 2018) were targeted at conducting PIA across 25 HVS in the State, with assessors shared across the different LGAs. The State Government and TCI team provided supervision during assessment of some of the facilities.</p> <p>The team synthesized findings from the assessment of the 25 sites into the PIA entry sheet on day 4 while the powerpoint for presentation of findings and the PIP was developed together on day 5.</p>

Implications for TCI	<p>The PIA will enable the state to document the level of HR capacity and status of infrastructure, equipment, commodity and tools across the facilities assessed. This will further guide interventions planned and enable the team implement an evidence based facility improvement as well as to classify the HVS into type 1 and type 2 health facilities for make-over.</p>
Next Steps	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Finalize the PIA/PIP presentation and share with the TCI Hub team for inputs. • Plan and disseminate the findings of the PIA to key stakeholders including technocrats and policy makers in the state through a CTU, • Support the State Government to gradually implement activities outlined on the PIP developed. • Conduct a repeat assessment to facilities selected for 72hr make-over to quantify needs with artisans.
