The Challenge Initiative's Global Executive Director Visits Pakistan to Foster Stronger Partnerships

"The bold leadership in reproductive healthcare that Pakistan is demonstrating is commendable, and The Challenge Initiative (TCI) is honored to stand by its side." - Mr. Kojo Lokko







Mr. Kojo Lokko, Executive Director of The Challenge Initiative (TCI) Global, undertook a high-profile visit to Pakistan. During the visit, he held meetings with senior political leadership and government officials in Punjab and Sindh. His interactions with the Ministry of National Health Services Regulations & Coordination (MoNHSRC) Integrated Reproductive, Maternal, Newborn and Child Health (IRMNCH) Department of Primary & Secondary Healthcare Program, and Lady Health Workers (LHW) Program demonstrated meaningful partnership between TCI – Greenstar Social Marketing (GSM), and local stakeholders.

Highlights: Dr. Malik Mukhtar Ahmad Bharath, Minister of State for MoNHSRC endorsed TCI's work, which has directly shaped national family planning reforms and emphasized the need to scale up essential services.

In Punjab, TCI held strategic meetings with senior officials, including **Dr. Khalil Ahmad** and **Dr. Hamza Tarar** from the Primary & Secondary Healthcare Department, **Mr. Salman Ijaz** (Secretary), **Ms. Saman Rai** (Director General), and **Dr. Nyla Altaf** (Additional Secretary Technial) from Population Welfare Department (PWD) with the objective to ensure consistent implementation of high impact interventions and their sustainability by embedding them into government health systems.

In Sindh, TCI had robust high-level dialogue with Honorable **Dr. Azra Fazal Pechuho** (Minister for Health

& Population), Mr. Rehan Baloch (Secretary Health) Dr. Khalid Memon (Deputy DG Reproductive, Maternal, Newborn and Child Health (RMNCH) & Dr. Farhana Memon (Program Director RMNCH) on issues of scale-up within the program, integration into health systems and ownership by stakeholders. In Islamabad, TCI team held thorough in depth with Dr. Malik Mukhtar Bharath, Dr. Shabana Saleem (Director General Health & FDI), Dr. Zaeem Zia (District Health Officer), and Dr. Rashida **Batool** (Deputy Health Officer) regarding upscaling of Family Health Services and their integration. The conversation also highlighted the significant role that mothers-in-law play in society, particularly in areas where the joint family system is more common. It was agreed that engaging the community and addressing often-overlooked indirect factors which directly impact service utilization would be a wise approach.

High officials from Pakistan commended TCI Pakistan for its proactive role in advancing family planning and health initiatives. The visit reinforced the shared vision in improving Mother & Child healthcare and expanding access to quality services throughout the country. The site visits to Lahore, Karachi & Islamabad provided an opportunity for officials to observe D4D meetings, media sensitization workshops, trainings, interactions with end-users and health service providers.

TCI-Greenstar Lahore Leads Groundbreaking Advocacy Workshop on Family Planning with Religious Leaders and Key Stakeholders

TCI-GSM organized an advocacy workshop on Family Planning, bringing together **70 influential** participants from **religious**, **educational**, and media sectors in Lahore on December 28, 2024. The event was graced by the presence of **Mr. Muhammad Afzal**, Deputy Director, IEC, Population Welfare Department (PWD), Punjab, who commended the initiative.

In a groundbreaking development, all Ulema pledged to observe the first Friday of 2025 as a public sensitization day for Family Planning. This initiative is expected to leverage the Ulema Council's platform to promote awareness and encourage responsible family planning practices across Country.

The workshop concluded with a closing address by Mr. Mazhar Iqbal, District Population Welfare Officer (DPWO), Lahore, who lauded TCI-GSM for its outstanding efforts. He emphasized the importance of sustaining such initiatives and urged all stakeholders to maintain their commitment to this critical cause.



TCI-Greenstar Launches Groundbreaking Training to Promote Couple-Based Family Planning in Rawalpindi

On December 11, 2024, in Rawalpindi, the TCI-GSM team, in collaboration with the Department of Health Rawalpindi, initiated a three-day Training of Trainers session on **Couple Counseling during the antenatal and postnatal periods**. The training covered essential topics, including the current family planning (FP) situation in Pakistan, counseling principles, and an overview of various FP methods. These sessions aimed to provide participants with a comprehensive understanding of the challenges and opportunities in family planning.


Diverse training programs are essential to enhancing family planning services in Pakistan. Traditionally, FP counseling has focused primarily on women. However, recognizing the crucial role men play in society and the traditional neglect of their involvement, this training emphasized the importance of shared responsibility between couples rather than placing the burden solely on one spouse.



Additional Users of Family Planning are continuously increasing due to the successful implementation of **High Impact Interventions**.

TCI-GSM, in close coordination with local government authorities, has been implementing High-Impact Interventions (HIIs) across 15 supported districts in Pakistan. Through sustained efforts and the provision of enhanced health services at designated facilities, both

HIIS and High-Impact Practices (HIPs) have demonstrated their effectiveness. These initiatives are steadily increasing client engagement and uptake of family planning (FP) services.



Celebrating the Unsung Heroes of Family Planning in Pakistan TCI-GSM organized a **Webinar** to acknowledge the untiring efforts of Field Staff

TCI-Pakistan team hosted a webinar to celebrate the efforts of Field staff and their published stories regarding male engagement and the effective counselling skills which led to vasectomy. TCI-Pakistan engaged speakers from Department of Health and Population Welfare Department from Sindh and Punjab and there were more than 100 online participants including partners and stakeholders from all intervention districts in Punjab and Sindh as well as leadership. Women Medical Officer (WMO), Lady Health Worker (LHW), Family Welfare Assistant (FWA) from Rawalpindi and Karachi Central shared the stories of women who had previously been unable to adopt any family planning method but, after receiving counselling from the staff, their husbands opted for sterilization, for the families' better future.

From November 11 till 14th 2024, During the annual meeting in the Philippines, the TCI Pakistan Hub highlighted its data-driven approach to shaping strategies and future programming. Analysing across facilities demonstrated improvements in High-Impact Interventions (HII) and High-Impact Practices (HIP), which informed strategic refinements for better implementation. Discussions also focused on refining interventions to better reach women, ensuring adaptability for long-term sustainability, and exploring primary health care integration. Looking beyond 2025, the hub reaffirmed its commitment to TCI's model, emphasizing leadership in sustainability, strengthening partnerships, and sustaining momentum for continued growth and impact.



National Collaboration Formalized: The Challenge Initiative–Greenstar Social Marketing (TCI–GSM) & Ministry of Health Sign Landmark Letter of Understanding (LoU)



On October 7, 2024, GSM and the District Health Officer Islamabad, under the leadership of Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations & Coordination, signed a Letter of Understanding (LoU), a key step for Pakistan's reproductive health landscape. The event, hosted at the DHO office Islamabad, was attended by parliamentarians, health management and service delivery teams, and development sector stakeholders to re-commit at the national level to family planning (FP) and maternal health.

Key Highlights:

The event was presided over by **Dr. Malik Mukhtar Ahmad Bharath**, the National Coordinator on Health to Prime Minister who assured the government efforts to ensure accessible FP services for the people in the country.

Members of the Parliamentary Assembly, including **Mr. Anjum Aqeel**, Chairman of the Standing Committee on Health & Education, lent critical political backing to this initiative.

The LoU was formally signed by the District Health Officer of Islamabad and the CEO of GSM to focus on the integration of public sector health facilities and outreach services of DOH Islamabad with the toll-free POOCHO Helpline, managed by GSM.

TCI-Trained Master Coaches Lead the Charge in Expanding Family Planning Services Across Khanewal, Pakistan



Since June 2023, The Challenge Initiative (TCI) has supported local governments in Pakistan to expand family planning services, Khanewal focusing on district. collaborates with the Department of Health and Population Welfare Department to implement high-impact practices like Postpartum Family Planning (PPFP) and Post-Abortion Family Planning (PAFP). These practices are integrated through activities like Family Health Days, on-the-job training, and site orientations to enhance healthcare providers' skills.

TCI's partnership with the Integrated Reproductive Maternal Newborn, Child Health & Nutrition Program (IRMNCH) led to quarterly training sessions at Khanewal District Headquarters Hospital. Approximately 50 participants were trained in counseling techniques, gender equality, and family planning methods, becoming Master Coaches who now implement these services across 82 health facilities.

The coaching model empowers Master Coaches to train frontline workers, including Lady Health Workers and Lady Health Visitors, ensuring sustainable improvements. Dr. Irum Rafique highlighted the program's adaptability and cost-effectiveness, while Sheela Anjum emphasized its role in addressing gaps in demand creation and service delivery. Dr. Nadia Khan praised TCI's accessible resources and focus on essential skills.

By institutionalizing these practices, TCI strengthens health systems and expands access to family planning services, reducing unintended pregnancies and improving maternal health in Khanewal.

Motorbike-Riding Lady Health Worker Empowers Women in Karachi West with Door-to-Door Family Planning Counselling and Services

Since October 2022, The Challenge Initiative (TCI) has been aiding Karachi's local governments to scale up family planning services. In Orangi Town, a densely populated urban slum in Karachi's West District, TCI has trained Master Coaches to implement high-impact practices such as postpartum and post-abortion family planning, whole site orientations, and integrated community outreaches. Lady Health Workers (LHWs) play a critical role in these efforts.

One standout Master Coach is Badar-un-Nisa, who uses a motorbike to efficiently deliver door-to-door family



planning services. Her innovative approach enables her to navigate narrow streets and cover extensive areas each day, delivering family planning commodities and raising awareness about birth spacing and maternal and child health benefits. Despite societal criticism and resistance, Badar-un-Nisa persevered with the support of her siblings and gradually gained community acceptance by emphasizing her mission.

Badar-un-Nisa's work extends beyond service delivery. On Family Health Days, she provides transportation for women to health facilities, enabling access to long-term and permanent contraception methods. Her efforts have increased community outreach and contributed to higher client volumes at health facilities.
